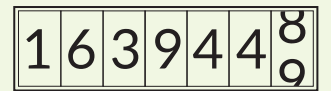

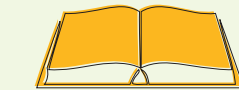
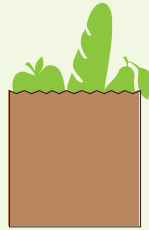

Pounds of food distributed to strengthen 30,000 families in need through the Mobile Pantry Program.



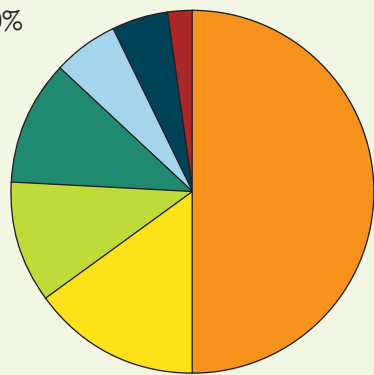

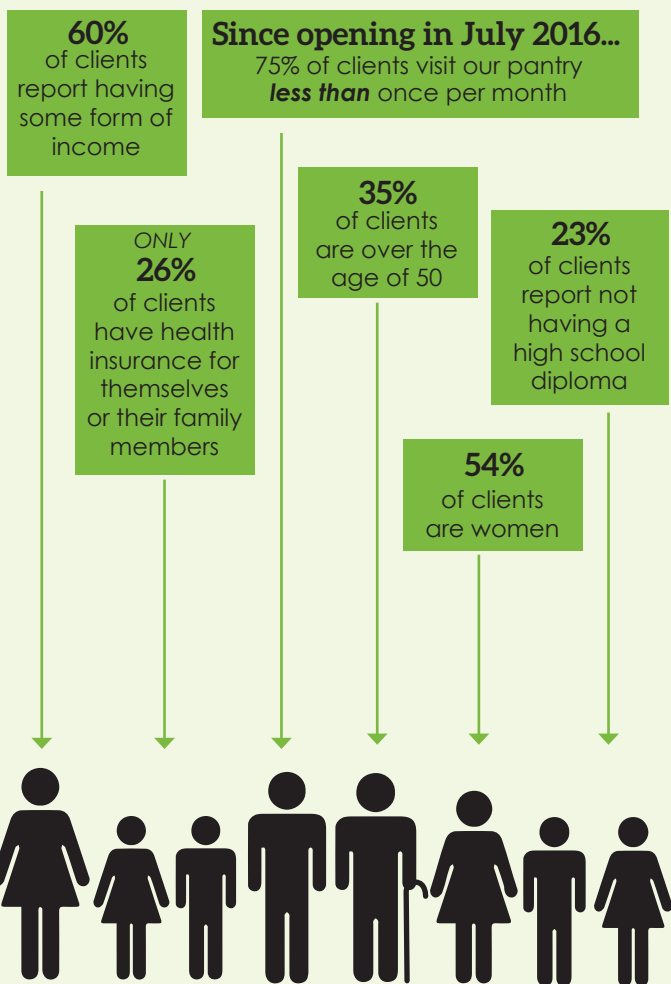
